

This gentleman underwent stress echocardiography on the 7th August. This showed a structurally normal heart with excellent biventricular systolic function and no significant valvular heart disease. There is no evidence of inducible ischaemia during dobutamine stress.

This investigation suggests no evidence of flow limiting coronary artery disease. He should continue with risk factor management. No further cardiology follow up is needed at the current time. Though of course we would be pleased to see him back should there be any change in his cardiac status.
